



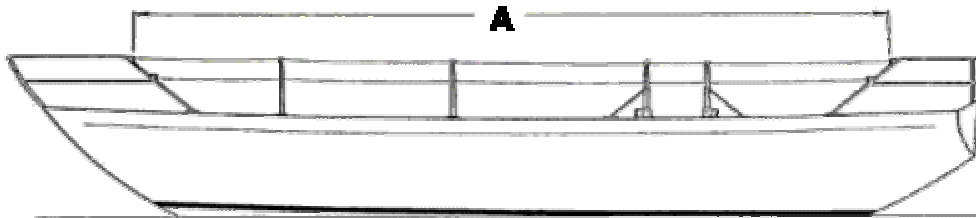

### How to measure for lifelines:

- Measure both sides of the boat for lifeline dimensions.
- Measure around all stanchions through which the lifeline must pass.
- Do not measure with rope. Use a tape measure.
- Indicate the maximum diameter that will pass through all stanchions.

### Upper and Lower Lifeline Dimensions:

- A – Distance from bearing surface of bow pulpit pad eye to bearing surface of the stern rail pad eye.
- Max Diameter – This is the maximum diameter of the wire and/or fitting that will pass through all of your stanchions. You can check this by measuring your existing lifeline terminals with calipers, or passing an object of a known diameter, such as a bolt, through your stanchion eyes.
